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- At the end Vice Chancellor shared skill development courses in the area of Agriculture, Domestic Workers, ITI, Plumber, Beauty and Wellness under NSQF of the UGC, approved for the session 2020-21 in the University .After that She asked the members for their advice /suggestions.
- Dr. D.C Katoch said that after going through the detailed agenda item/ points and action taken report of the Senate of the University, he appreciated the work done by the IEDC cell of the University and shared /advise the following certain activities in the area of Health Sciences that can be taken up by the University School of Ayurveda and Research and give assurance to support for same.
 - To provide Technical and Financial support for applying health Science projects, which is available on the web-site of Central Government.
 - To advise to grow medicine plants e.g Brahmi, Ashwagandha, Ambla and Tulsi , which are grown naturally in Punjab and can be cultivated also.
 - To provide support in providing good agricultural practices and good field cultivation training to the farmers of Punjab, as per the guidelines of National Medicine Plant Board , (as he was one of the members of the board for preparing guidelines, when he was in WHO).
 - To focus on Skill based programme of short term basis along with orientationprogramme /training program to the people at large, in which he assured to give help to the University in finding out those skills that is the need of the hours during Covid in Punjab and the University can apply for same for technical and financial support.
 - To find out/create an opportunity for virtual Innovation and development in health Science sectors, which leads the University to the scientific institutions.
 - To plan to start courses and provide training on Panchakarma therapy and Yoga, as there is an urgent need in Punjab during Covidpandemonic.
 - To start programmes on Life style education and to provide Lifestyle counselling and training to the society and people of Punjab at large as it is utmost need in Punjab at present , as they will have to know , how to maintain peace of mind, how to take healthy .

The panel thanked Dr. Dinesh for sharing their valuable suggestions/advise and will give assurance to take up the same in the University .

- Dr. Birinderjit Singh suggested that in this hard time University should extend helping hand to its alumni by offering various business ventures which have been already evolved and successfully commissioned by the university. Sarpanches of the villages located in the vicinity of the University may be apprised about various agro based tiny and cottage industries which can be established under Govt. schemes in their villages for generating employment for the educated unemployed.
