About the University

Desh Bhagat University, Mandi Gobindgarh came into existence under Punjab Govt's Desh Bhagat University Act 2013. The university derives its spirit of foundation from freedom fighter Sr. Lal Singh Ji; who fought for the independence of India and in 1972 his efforts of social work and his services in the freedom struggle were recognized by awarding him with "TamraPatra" by Govt. of India, hence the name Desh Bhagat was contemplated. DBU has been established with the mission of pursuing excellence in higher education as envisioned by Sr. Lal Singh Ji.

Academic working:

The University follows a formal academic calendar for each year and is divided into two semesters. The total number of instruction days, excluding examination days, was 92 in both the semesters. The details of the same have been provided in **Annexure – I**

Review of Curriculum



- The University follows a continuous review system of the curriculum and as per feedback and suggestions of alumni, local and global need required changes are done. The university has uploaded online feed back system.
- The curriculum is focused on topics pertaining to employability, entrepreneurship and skill enhancement. Various activities related to the same have been incorporated as per the club data with the introduction of various technical and life skill clubs.
- Value added courses have been added in curriculum of every stream as per the Swayam and MOOC courses of UGC.
- The university time table has been focused to deal with number of issues of students and so more emphasis is on Mentor –Mentee Concept.
- University has taken an initiative for advanced as well as slow learner’s students. Advanced learner students are actively engaged in organizing in various club activities whereas university has focused for remedial classes for the slow learner students so as to enhance their academic potential.
- The syllabus of the entire faculty has updated as per the UGC Guidelines and Choice Bases Credit System (CBCS) has been implemented in all except council courses i.e Pharmacy, Dental Sciences, Nursing , Ayurveda , BE.d and law.

Faculty

- Human Resource Development Cell (HRDC) is the important aspect for the growth of any higher education institute.
- Desh Bhagat University makes special efforts for recruitment and retention of quality faculty.
- Number of doctorate faculty has been recruited in the year 2019-2020 in different streams so as to provide quality based academic input to the students.

Faculty awards for Excellence

University has also instituted a Performance Awards Scheme (PAS) in Teaching; Academic Research; Projects/Consultancy and Contributions to University Activities. The awards are given based on API score of faculty. These awards are given annually. The institution has laid policy of incentives to teachers who receive state, national and international recognitions/awards as Commendation and monetary incentive at a University function/Commendation and medal at a University function/Certificate of honor

Research and Development

- Compared to the last few years, the year 2019-2020 can be considered a year focused on research growth of the university.



- Desh Bhagat University has laid down the policy guidelines with an objective to boost research development among young faculty members and for creation of knowledge through research.
- Seed Money are funds provided to finance the initial stages of a new venture, utilized to conduct research, to develop the prototype for a product or determine if an idea is workable or economically viable. Total Seed Money Grants Distributed over period of five years is Rs. 37,16,500 and in year 2019-20 total seed money grant distributed is Rs. - 10,15,320 ..Total seed money grant is distributed among number of research projects, research papers, workshops, seminars and ventures.
- Total Grants for research projects sponsored by the non-government sources such as industry, corporate houses, international bodies, endowments, Chairs in the institution during the last five years is Rs. 45,35,692 and during 2019-20 total grants amount to Rs. 59,60,418.
- Total Grants for research projects sponsored by the government sources such as EDI, NIMST.DST, ICSSR, PSCST during the last five years is Rs. 43,97,000.
- Total Grants sanctioned and Funded by Government bodies during the year 2019-2020 has contributed a lot for making the university a research based campus. A grant of Rs 19,96,750 has been funded by DST for establishment of a Women Technology Park . ICSSR has sanctioned a grant of Rs 12,60,000 for a project on current issue in Punjab i.e. Stubble Burning.

Patents: University has applied for about 10 patents and 2 copyrights in different fields. The application has been submitted to the Patent Office.

Consultancy

University is focused on consultancy and the total Revenue generated from consultancy during the last five years is Rs. 1,058,409 and during 2019-2020 is Rs.10,31,690/

ACADEMIC WORKING

The University follows a formal academic calendar for each year that is divided into two semesters. Due to COVID-19 situation, University opted online system/Offline/Blended mode of education for teaching and learning so that academic year of students is not disturbed.

AWARD OF DEGREES AND MEDALS

- As per ordinance and statute of the university all final degrees to pass out students will be awarded in every year on 14th Feb, 2014.
- In 09th convocation of the university the number of degrees awarded to pass out students through offline mode. 71 Ph.D/M.Phil Degrees, 656 UG degrees and 92 Diplomas are awarded in this convocation.

REVIEW OF CURRICULUM

- DBU has concentrated on the holistic development of the students to make them healthy students of our country by providing them best quality higher education and excellent infrastructure facilities. Now DBU is providing education under 14 faculties, under 31 departments. We are imparting education as per standards and norms of UGC, DCI CCIM, INC, BCI, PCI and NCTE etc.
- To give international and national exposure to the students and to help them become a part of global scenario, DBU has signed MOU with as many as 14 institutes of repute.
- The University follows a continuous review system of the curriculum and as per feedback and suggestions of stakeholders like alumni; local and global needs the required changes have been done. The University is furnished with online feedback system. We are further working on enhancement to add more features for better retrieval of the feedback details. About 10% courses of syllabi are changed in the area of Computer Science and application and in other areas in this year.
- The syllabus of the entire faculty has been updated as per the UGC Guidelines and Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) has been implemented in all except council courses i.e. Dental Sciences, Nursing, Ayurveda, Education and Law. However the curriculum of all courses is focused on topics pertaining to employability, entrepreneurship and skill enhancement.
- Value added courses have been added in curriculum of every stream as per the SWAYAM and MOOC courses of UGC. About 20% Value added courses of other courses have been introduced from the session 2020-21.



- Around 103 new courses have been introduced in this year, now more than 70% courses focused on Employability, Entrepreneurship and Skill Enhancement.
- The University has incorporated Mentor Mentee Concept to encourage and empower students in personal development in order to identify and achieve career goals. The time table is focused on concept of slow and advanced learner so that advanced learner students are actively engaged in organizing various club activities whereas the University has focused for remedial classes for the slow learner students so as to enhance their academic potential.
- Internship of students was in 11 programmes (Previously it was in 27 programmes) hence decrease in 40% due to Covid-19 pandemic.
- The University (DBU) follows a student centric academic philosophy to ensure the holistic development of students and offers a learning environment which fosters critical thinking, exploration, creativity and innovation.
- University explores learning-centric methods like participative learning, experiential learning, and problem-solving methodologies to enhance learning experiences among teachers and students. Experiential learning method considers the individual learning process where a group of students is assigned to a teacher who nurtures and takes care of them.
- Classes of small groups are organized throughout the semester to build and shape up the perspective of the students. University encourages and implements participative learning to focus on enhanced learning of students. DBU organizes various academic and non-academic activities from time to time and motivates students to participate in such events & programs to foster active learning and strives to engage students in the learning process directly and develop a healthy & interactive environment

IEEE BRANCH:

University has recently collaborated with IEEE and established IEEE Desh Bhagat University student branch that is a student chapter of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE). It is a student oriented branch having a motive to groom our passionate students, to have fun and meet new people, gather new experiences and develop industrial skills to learn about research and innovation in technology, to serve community.



FACULTY

- Human Resource Development Cell (HRDC) is the important aspect for the growth of any higher education institute. Faculty is actively associated with National platforms like Atal Academy cell and regularly undertaking and participating in Refresher Courses & Orientation Courses from various HRDC Centers. In addition we make special efforts for recruitment and retention of quality faculty.
- Abiding to the norms of UGC, number of doctorate faculty has been recruited in the year 2020-2021 in different streams so as to provide quality based academic input to the students.

ORIENTATION, REFRESHER, AND FDP 2020-2021

- Human Resource Development Centre (HRDC) of Desh Bhagat University functions under the IQAC as a vital part of the institution from the year 2012. This initiative was launched for enhancing the academic, psycho-social, and administrative proficiency of the teaching and non-teaching staff of the college. Strengthening the intellectual infrastructure of the faculty will foster the rapid progress of the institution. The centre provides faculty and administrators with access to rich academics and innovative approaches to learning and problem solving.
- Orientation programmes are specially designed for newly appointed lecturers and refresher courses are meant for in service teachers. The Orientation programme is intended to inculcate in the young lecturers the quality of self-reliance through awareness of the social, intellectual and moral environment as well as to discover self-potential and confidence. The Refresher course provides opportunities for serving teachers to exchange experiences with their peers and mutually learns from each other. It will be a forum to abreast of the latest advances in the subjects, technological spin off etc.
- In the academic year 2019-2020, 41 professional development programs conducted by HRDC. In the academic year 2020-2021, 48 professional development programs conducted by HRDC.

FACULTY AWARDS FOR EXCELLENCE

Consultancy and Contributions to University activities. The awards are given based on API score of the faculty. These awards are given annually. Based on CAS, a number of promotions have been done based on fulfillment of criteria for the same.

RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT

- Compared to the last few years, this year 2020-2021 can be considered a year focused on research growth of the University.
- Desh Bhagat University has laid down the policy guidelines with an objective to boost research development among young faculty members and for creation of knowledge through research.
- Any university gains recognition and reputation through its research. DBU had created a rich for itself through its research projects, which are funded by DBT, ICSSR, EDI, NIMST, PSCST.
- At present university has received finances from Govt as well as Non Govt sources such as industry, corporate houses, Endowments, international bodies, etc for promotion of research.
- To strengthen the research and inculcate the research culture, DBU has been providing seed money to young researchers to support and finance them at initial stages of their new ventures. This year, University has given 20.53 Lakh to their faculty for their research activities, in previous year, it was 9.97 lakh.
- A part of research policy, the faculty was provided seed money to number of faculty members for interdisciplinary research, attending national or international webinars. Our faculty members are working on application based research projects under grants from Govt, non govt. And university. Sponsored research projects.
- Total Grants sanctioned and Funded by Government bodies during the last five years has contributed a lot for making the university a research based campus. A grant of Rs 19.96 lakhs has been funded by DST for establishment of a Women Technology Park. ICSSR has sanctioned a grant of Rs 12.60 lakhs for a project on current issue in Punjab i.e. Stubble Burning and an amount of Rs. 44.15 Lakh has been applied for grant to the Department of Science and Technology , New Delhi for research projects on "Impact of Bachelor Programme(B.Ed) education on Student Teachers in Developing Professional Competencies For Handling Learning Disability" and "A Study Of Prevalence And Demographic Correlates Of Developmental Dyscalculia In Punjab"



- Total Nos. of 10 enrollment in the year 2020-21 and 7 in the year 2019-20 in the JRFs, SRFs, Post-Doctoral Fellows, Research Associates and other research fellows in the university.
- Extramural funding for Research (Grants sponsored by the non-government sources such as industry, corporate houses, and international bodies for research projects) is 70.44 Lakh in the year 2019-20 and in the year 2020-21, it was 130.89 Lakh.
- No's of Ph.D Awarded in the year 2019-20 was 45, but the Nos. of Ph.D awarded increased as 75, hence 66.67% increase in this year.

We have established Udhmi entrepreneurial Hub for providing a space for exhibition of products made by local entrepreneur to provide a platform to them for business.

1. Community engagement service known as university best practice help students learn address real needs and by solving real problems they learn to apply classroom learning to real world context. It has not only benefited local community, it has also touched lives of students who are uncertain about their direction. The local communities around the university campus in itself demonstrated the situational challenges of the villagers and thus gave the opportunity to create an empathy with these communities for lack of proper medical facilities, carrier guidance and counseling to youth, lack of awareness about



rights, health and hygiene. The students and faculty through its various clubs like Swachh Bharat, Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, NSS, Eco club, Gender champion club and various departmental clubs serve in the adopted villages.

1. Desh Bhagat Dental hospital and Ayurvedic hospital organize camps in adopted villages. Dental hospital has a satellite hospital which has been treating patients in village and till date has treated more than 700 patients.
2. Desh Bhagat Ayurvedic hospital has been organizing medical camps in adopted villages and around 100 villages with providing free medicines and consultancy.
3. Covid – 19 Vaccination Drive has been done under the close monitoring of Civil Surgeon Office Fatehgarh Sahib with target to total – 600 Persons to be vaccinated till 20/05/2021.
4. In addition to the covid 19 services, we have established Govt. Approved Desh Bhagat Covid Testing Centre – for RAT (Rapid Antigen Testing). Around Total – 2268 RAT Tests done
5. In addition we have been distributing Free immunity Vati Distribution Drive (Door to Door) to 5 adopted villages to the immune-compromised vulnerable group
6. Kisan Mela is organized as an extension activity for farmers to provide a platform where farmers can interact with experts, gain knowledge about latest technology. DBU has been organizing Kisan Mela since 2018 every year in month of March and has received a good response every year., but during the covid-19, it was postponed
7. University has outstretched its facilities during pandemic. University staff was trained for providing services in the pandemic situation for which faculty was awarded by various organizations for their outstanding contribution during lockdown. Staff was trained to make sanitizer and masks that was distributed in the villages free of cost. Sanitization of adopted villages was done. University provided facility of 40 bedded hospital to district administration as quarantine centre.
8. DBU organize legal camps involving as It is requisite to properly educate children about drugs abuse awareness. Various scholarships are provided to the students which motivate students to take up higher studies. IEDC incubators provide various skill development courses and organize workshops to develop skills in people so that they can support themselves.

EVIDENCE OF SUCCESS:

The increase in demand of medical camps and positive response of patients, agricultural extension service and the appreciation letters that the officials have given to acknowledge the efforts speaks in



itself for the evidence of success. Response of farmers in Kisan Mela organized by university every year and increased number of participants, audiences and visitors is evidence of success of efforts of the university. Some villagers have got connected with the students and teachers and always look forward for the new approach and connection. Community service has helped students to use their talents and knowledge to change lives including their own.

IT INFRASTRUCTURE

During pandemic we enhanced IT infrastructure in campus. University added 20 smart boards for class rooms, RFID technology in Library, softwares and computers for Computer research centre and increased internet bandwidth from 50 Mbps to 1 GB for smooth functioning of digital processes.

LIBRARY

Total amount of 43,49,950/- has spent in the purchase of Library Books , Print Journals , e-books , e-journals and e-database for all courses in the University (Previous year, it was Rs 22,23,644/-) hence the incremental improvement is 51.11% in this year.

RENEWABLE RESOURCES AND CONSERVATION OF ENERGY

We have gradually shifted to use LED and have replaced 65% lights. We have installed 20 solar lights in campus. Solar power plant of 3 Kwh is installed. Biogas produced from biogas plant installed in boys hostel has been used in mess intensively and reduced use of LPG gas cylinder by 10/month and have helped in managing solid waste of hostels. New ramps and washrooms are constructed for differently abled. We have conducted around 150 awareness activities for sensitive issues like gender sensitization, environment, social harmony, code of conduct, right and duties and important commemorative days through virtual mode due to pandemic. The university uses the renewable energy sources for its hostels boys and girls and township in the form of geysers, solar cooker and street lights. This year we have started producing electricity through rooftop grid connected solar photovoltaic power plant and the first phase of the same is successfully implemented in this building only we have established energy park for dissemination of renewable energy concept among the students and moved on to LED and solar lights from normal lights in the campus. This year we started with biogas plant for the energy conservation in the hostels green auditors and energy audits are as usual part of the yearly routine. This year we added around 50,000 liters of rainwater harvesting capacity to already 50000 litres capacity available totaling 100000 liters of rainwater harvesting capacity in the campus.
