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Action Taken Report of the Feedback received from the Stakeholders Faculty wise/Department Wise

Considering the need to upgrade the curriculum from time to time, feedback survey among the major stakeholders like Students, Teachers, Alumni and Employers was conducted through online mode via Google Forms. The feedback received was analyzed by the members of IQAC and necessary actions required to be taken were suggested, on the basis of which actions were formulated.

Students commonly agree that the curriculum of UG and PG programs is useful, relevant and is updated according to the needs of the present day. It includes important topics to acquire professional and entrepreneurial skills for self development and contribution towards nation building.

Teacher's feedback was mainly about the quality and updated contents of each subject. They expressed that the regular updating of curriculum is fit enough to cater the professional needs which can make the students at par with the Local, National and Global standards.

Alumni were contended with the curriculum offered and training acquired from the course structure and appreciated the course contents for its focus on hands-on-trainings, field visits, industrial tours and personality development programs.

Most of the Parents appreciated for efforts and support of the teachers and the Institute. They expressed that they could see many positive changes in their wards towards their study.
