## Youth Festival Dbuzz-2025 Celebrates Culture and Talent at Desh Bhagat University Campus

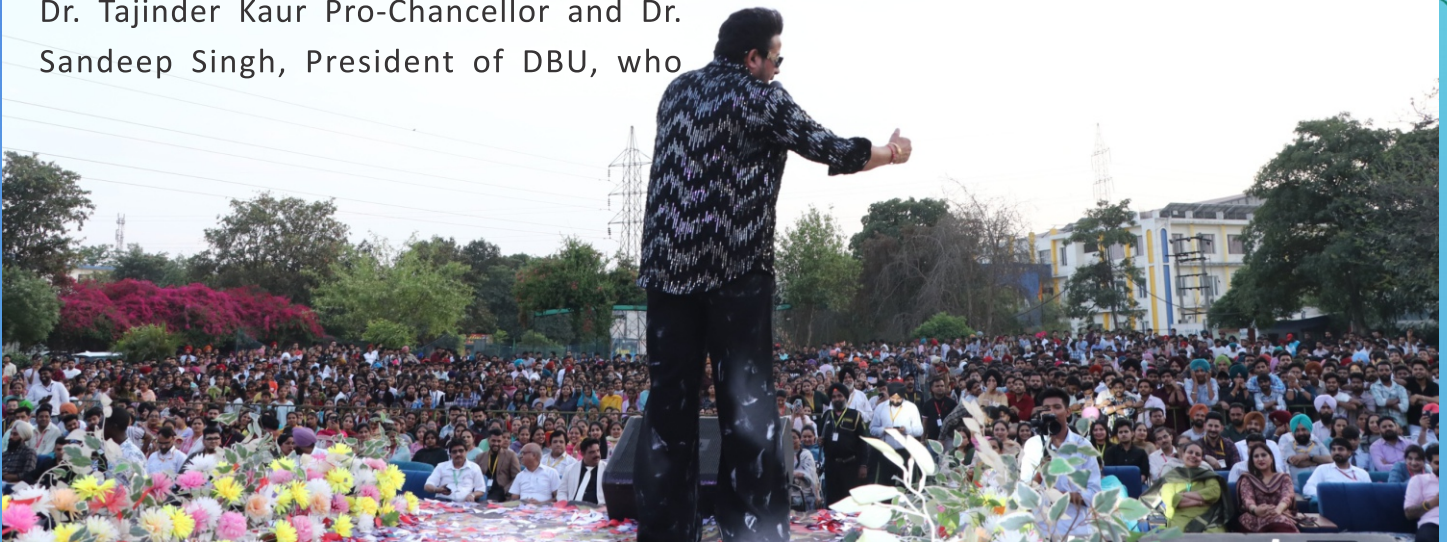
