

Desh Bhagat University houses a central library along with separate libraries in each faculty to provide its students and staff a chance to explore a world of knowledge in a conducive environment. By making accessible a rich collection of print and non-print, primary and secondary material in various disciplines, the libraries support the academic as well as research needs of thousands of students and hundreds of academicians of the University.

Key Highlights

- ERP software is used in the libraries for managing circulation of books, is completely an automatic process which enables students and staff to search, request for, and reserve books and other reference material in the library.
- Membership with EBSCO, DELNET & ELSEVIER (National Digital Library of UGC) enables access to international and national journals of various subjects/ disciplines, promotes resource sharpening among the libraries through development of a network within objective of collecting, storing and disseminating information besides offering computerized services to users to coordinate efficiently for suitable collection development (remove this word) and also to reduce unnecessary duplication wherever possible.
- University faculties are members of IDC (Information Dissemination Centre) through which the students have access to Indian and foreign journals free of cost. Horticulture Lab

Horticulture is the main stream that deals with producing vegetables and fruits that completes our basic requirement of food and nutrition. Department has equipped horticulture lab. In addition to basic knowledge in horticulture, with practical experience, students will be familiar with a wide range of subject matter including plant identification, propagation, controlled environment production, horticulture information retrieval system, pruning, and lawn care, plants for interior uses, and fruits and vegetables.



Plant Breeding and Genetics Lab

This lab is equipped with basic instruments that help students to understand the basic concepts of genetics, helping students to develop their analytical, quantitative and problem solving skills. To provide insight into structure and functions of chromosomes, chromosome mapping, polyploidy and cytogenetic aspects of crop evolution.



Agronomy Lab

The Lab has also equipment's related to crop physiology. It includes sprayers, Weighing Balance, Brix meter, EC meter etc.



Plant Pathology

Plant Pathology lab deals providing basic knowledge about the laboratory equipment and their working, culture media, procedures necessary for sterilization, culturing of microorganisms. Student are made familiar with the identification and growth of microorganisms in culture.



Biochemistry Lab



Herbarium collections aid in identifying and cataloging medicinal plants, enriching understanding and application of Dravyaguna principles. It has well organized museum, herbal gardan and pharmacognosy lab.
- **Rasashastra & Bhaishajyakalpana:** Rasashastra involves the study of mineral and metallic substances in Ayurveda, while Bhaishajyakalpana deals with the preparation and formulation of Ayurvedic medicines. It has GMP certified pharmacy, museum and quality control lab .
- **Roga Nidan & Vikriti Vigyan:** This branch is concerned with the diagnosis and understanding of diseases, including their causes, symptoms, and prognosis. It has a well equipped lab.
- **Agada Tantra:** Agada Tantra specializes in toxicology, encompassing the identification, treatment, and prevention of poisoning.

Pharmacists prepare antidotes in the pharmacy, utilizing knowledge from Agada Tantra. Herbarium collections aid in identifying toxic plants and their antidotes, contributing to effective treatments and preventive measures.

- **Swasthavritta & Yoga:** Swasthavritta focuses on preventive healthcare and lifestyle practices for maintaining good health, while Yoga incorporates various physical, mental, and spiritual practices to promote well-being.

- **Shalakya Tantra:** Shalakya Tantra focuses on the diagnosis and treatment of diseases related to the head and neck region, including ophthalmology, otolaryngology, and dentistry.
- **Prasuti Tantra & Stree Roga:** Prasuti Tantra deals with obstetrics and gynecology, including the care of pregnant women and management of childbirth, while Stree Roga focuses on women's health issues and diseases.

Programmes Offered:

ANM (Auxiliary Nurse & Midwife)

Duration: 2 Years

Eligibility Criteria:

- The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
- Angawadi, Asha workers and Trained Dias for admission to ANM course in Government Multipurpose Health Worker Training Schools/ANM schools shall be relaxed from 35 years to 42 years.

GNM (General Nursing and Midwifery)

Duration: 3 Years

Eligibility Criteria

- Minimum education eligibility criteria for admission to GNM:
- 10+2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English individually from any recognized board.
- Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government. However Science is preferable. Three (core elective) subject marks may be taken for calculating the percentage of marks excluding the marks in English. Also, it has to be ensured the candidate has pass marks in English.
- 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in vocational ANM course from the school recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
- 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in Vocational Stream Health care Science from a recognized CBSE board/State/Centre.
- Registered ANM with pass marks.

For foreign nationals

- The entry qualification equivalency i.e., 12th standard will be obtained by Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi. Institution and SNRC will be responsible to ensure that the qualification and eligibility will be equivalent to what has been prescribed by the Council.

B.SC. NURSING

Duration: 4 Years (VIII Semesters)

Eligibility Criteria:

- The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.

Minimum Educational Qualification

- Candidate with Science who have passed the qualifying 12th Standard examination (10+2) and must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together and passed in English individually.
- Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government having Science subjects and English only.
- English is a compulsory subject in 10+2 for being eligible for admission to B.Sc. (Nursing).
- Colour blind candidates are eligible provided that colour corrective contact lens and spectacles are worn by such candidates.
- Candidate shall be medically fit.
- Married candidates are also eligible for admission.
- Students shall be admitted once in a year.
- Selection of candidates should be based on the merit of the entrance examination. Entrance test** shall comprise of:

- The minimum educational requirements shall be the passing of 12 years of schooling (10+2 year course) recognized by CBSE/ICSE/SSSCE/HSC or a recognized equivalent examination.
- Admission is subject to satisfactory medical examination report.
- Admission for ANM is restricted only for female candidates.

NOTE- Admission/Examination body is Punjab Nurses Registration Council, Mohali

Reservation Policy

Anti-Ragging measures are taken as per guidelines of various authorities such as-

- With the direction of Hon'ble Supreme court of India, dated 8-5-2009 (in Civil Appeal No. 887 of 2009)
- Guidelines of University Grants Commission vide www.ugc.ac.in
- Punjab Govt. as per The Punjab Educational Institutions (Prohibition of Ragging) Act, 2013 Punjab Act No. 25 of 2013
- Decisions taken from time to time by District level Anti Ragging Committee constituted under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner

As per the orders/ Instructions/ guidelines issued by the above mentioned authorities, the following steps are taken in the University:

- An Anti Ragging Committee has been Constituted at the University level.
- Anti Ragging Squad has been constituted to ensure proper compliance of various instructions relating to prevention of ragging in the University.
- A monitoring cell has been established to co-ordinate the activities relating to prevention of ragging by the students in the University Campus / Hostels.

GENERAL

- Students are expected to maintain the highest standards of discipline and dignified manner of behavior inside campus. They shall abide by the rules and regulations of the University and should act in a way that highlights the discipline and esteem of the University.
- A five-day working schedule from Monday to Friday is followed. Classes are scheduled from 9.15 a.m. to 4.45 p.m. Students should enter the campus in time. Once the students enter the campus they shall not be allowed to leave before the end of the academic classes or after obtaining prior approval from HOD.
- It is imperative that the student attends the University from the day of opening to the last day of each semester during the academic year.
- Students must carry his/her I-Card every day while attending university. The student must wear the university uniform on the specified days, during visits outside the campus, or as specified from time to time..
- The student should note that he/she is responsible to the authorities of the University not only for his / her conduct on the premises of the University but also for his/her general behavior outside.
- Use of tobacco & alcohol, chewing of betel leaves and chewing gums, etc. are strictly prohibited within the premises of the University.
- Students are strictly forbidden from organizing or attending any unauthorized meeting in the University or collecting money for any purpose without the prior written permission of the Higher Authorities.
- Students are forbidden from organizing Groups, Unions, or Associations based on caste, color, creed, language, nationality or political ideology within the campus.
- Any reported, observed, objectionable conduct within or outside the premises of the University will make him/her liable for strict disciplinary action.
- Students should respect and be courteous towards the members of the faculty as well as all the employees of the University.
- The University maintains absolute discipline and students violating this are liable for severe penalties including expulsion.
- Students expelled on grounds of indiscipline will not be entitled to any certification or refund of fees and caution deposits.
- Ragging of any sort is strictly prohibited. Students found guilty of this are liable for severe punishment including dismissal from the University / Hostel. The matter will be referred to the police, as the Government has declared ragging a criminal offense.
- Any student found responsible for any damage to the University properties (fittings, furniture and equipment, etc.) will be punished severely and the cost of damages along with the fine will be recovered from the students. The University reserves the right to expel such students.
- No student shall take part in any anti-social or rebellious activities. No student shall be a member of any group, organization, or association not connected with the University, without the prior written permission of the Principal.
- Students should conduct themselves at all times in a fitting manner so as to bring credit to themselves and to the University.
- Any dress code violation noticed within the campus is liable to disciplinary actions.
- Keep the campus neat and clean. Do not put any waste anywhere on the campus except in the waste baskets kept.
- It is strongly advised to refrain from activities such as scribbling or noting on walls, doors, or furniture which could deface the university and destroy the academic ambiance.
- Students are not permitted to arrange any unauthorized celebrations and decorations of any magnitude on campus.
- Students are not permitted to distribute or display (both physically and electronically) material such as notices, banners, etc. on the campus without the permission of the competent authority.
- Students who intend to represent the university in intercollegiate events shall take prior permission from the concerned head of the department and the selection will be based on parameters such as academic performance, attendance, character, existing academic load, and competence of the student in the proposed event for participation.
- Students should strive hard and contribute to maintain peace on campus. If a student gets proven in a case of gross misconduct such as violence, riots or disorderly behavior, fraud, misappropriation of funds, or immoral conduct directed on a fellow student or faculty or staff, He will be subject to immediate expulsion from the University.
- In matters of indiscipline, the decision of the director, committee, or the concerned authority will be final.

ACADEMICS

- The use of mobile phones in the classroom is banned. The mobile phones shall be kept in silent mode inside the Institute.
- Students must be regular in attendance for theory and practical classes. In case the attendance falls short of minimum requirement fixed by council/ UGC i.e. 75 or 80 percent for each, students will not be allowed to sit for the examination.
- Students must maintain punctuality while attending all the theory and practical classes.
- There will be two MST's during the semester out of which best of the two will be taken for internal assessment.
- The internal assessment/ of the session will be based on the continuous evaluation of students through attendance, class tests/ mid semester tests, quizzes, seminars, home assignments and class work.
- No student will be allowed to appear in the final examinations without clearing his/her college dues/satisfactory performance. Students damaging college property will be severely dealt with.
- Students should especially note that if the student fails to complete the semester academic work regularly and to the entire satisfaction of the Head of the Department, his/her term will not be granted, and will not be allowed to appear for the semester examination.
- Students are expected to maintain silence in the academic buildings to maintain decorum and any deviant behavior such as hooting, whistling, loitering, etc. will be treated as an instance of indiscipline.
- Planned absence from classes and instigating the students to remain absent or to go on strike is a serious breach of discipline and may result in expulsion from the Institute.
- For independent study, students are expected to use the classrooms, library, or the demarcated areas of the academic building and shall not resort to sitting in staircases or circulation areas where they could interfere with the free movement.
- Access to academic buildings beyond the above timing and on holidays without written permission from the concerned HOD will be treated as a case of indiscipline.
- Students should observe the safety regulations in the workshop and laboratories.
- Students should take care of tools, apparatus, or other equipment given to them and should preserve the cleanliness of the laboratories and the workshop.
- Students should avail themselves of all opportunities to acquire knowledge and skills during their period of study.

HOSTEL RULES

- Attendance shall be taken daily in the evening at a specified time. Parents shall be informed in case the resident is found absent. Mobile phones are not allowed at the time of Attendance.
- It is compulsory for all the students residing in the hostel to eat in the hostel mess at dining tables only. In case of sickness food may be taken to room with prior permission of the hostel warden. Mess timing will be notified.
- No function or a party shall be organized in the Hostel without the written permission of the Director/Principal.
- Rooms should be kept neat and clean, students are fully responsible for any damage to the hostel property. Defaulters shall be penalized.
- Cupboards should be properly locked. Jewelry, Cash and other Expensive items are not allowed to be kept in the rooms. The college authority is not responsible for any loss of such items.
- Use of Heaters//Electric iron in the rooms is prohibited.
- Director/Principal/Hostel Warden or a person nominated by the Director can check the hostel rooms any time.
- Relatives, outsiders and day scholars are not permitted in the rooms.
- Parents/Guardians should visit the students during specified visiting hours only in the warden's office on Sundays & holidays (Timing 9 AM to 5 PM). No male/female visitor is permitted inside the girls/boys hostel premises.
- Students are not allowed to meet any visitor, not mentioned in the list of visitors permitted by the parents or guardians which is submitted at the time of admission.
- Indiscipline shall be dealt with strictly.
- The students cannot go out without the approval of their parents on a printed Performa then only they may be allowed to go out on their own (Printed Performa can be collected from wardens).
- A student can leave the hostel only on obtaining the gate-pass from the hostel warden for the same and one pass is valid for one student only.
- Absence from the hostel without permission is not permitted. Defaulter shall be dealt strictly.
- The student should positively return to the hostel by the notified time, otherwise he/she will not be allowed to enter without the permission of Warden/Principal/Director. Parents are requested to cooperate.
- If any student extends her leave period for night stay, the parents / guardians should inform the hostel warden within 24 hrs. Otherwise serious action will be taken against the student.
- Students should switch off the lights or fans before leaving the rooms. Failure to do so will invite a penalty.
- Parents are required to inform the Hostel Warden when students reach their home.
- Students are not allowed to interchange the rooms without written permission from college authorities.
- Smoking and drinking alcohol/drugs is strictly prohibited in the institute/hostel.
- Mess Timings:
- The mess timings are usually determined/ fixed by the hostel warden.

LIBRARY RULES

- Library card (LC) will be issued to the staff and students of the college. Others can use the library only with special permission from the authorities.
- LC will be issued to the registered members which is non-transferable & to be renewed every year.
- A lost Library Card, if found, should be immediately deposited in the library.
- Intimation of the loss of LC must be reported to concerned authorities in order to avoid any misuse.
- The timings for the issue and return of the books will be as notified.
- Personal books and belongings are to be deposited at the property counter near the library entrance. Members should not leave valuable items like cash/mobile/jewelry etc. at the property counter.
- Taking books out of the library without authorization, marking or underlining or in any way disfiguring books or library property is a misdemeanor, which may lead to withdrawal of Library privileges or in serious cases to heavy fines.
- The 'No dues Certificate' can be secured from the library after surrendering the Library Pass Book and clearing all library dues.
- Change of address should immediately be reported to the issuing authorities.
- No library reading material would be considered returned until it has been returned to the library personally at the circulation counter.
- The last borrower shall be responsible for any damage to the reading material unless it was pointed out at the time of issue.
- Number of books to be issued will be notified.
- Students not returning the books by the due date will be charged fine.
- University employees are not responsible for any loss/damage of belonging.

International Students

Rules framed by University Grants Commission (UGC) and notified in its website www.ugc.ac.in will be followed for deciding the eligibility and admissions of International students to various courses offered in DBU. International Students Cell (ISC): DBU has set up an 'International Students Cell' to deal with admission and guidance of international students. This Cell will control the admission of the international students and provide necessary guidance for securing admission. All letters relating to international students will be addressed to 'Incharge International Admissions' of DBU

1.1 Guidelines for admission of Foreign/International Students

As per guidelines, 'International Students' will include the following:

- Foreign Students: Students holding passports issued by foreign countries and people of Indian origin who have acquired the nationality of foreign countries are included as foreign students.
- Non Residents Indians (NRI): Only those non resident Indian Students who have studied and passed the qualifying examinations from schools or colleges in foreign countries will be included as international students. This will include the students studying in the schools or colleges situated in foreign countries even if they are affiliated to Boards of Secondary Education or Universities located in India, but will not include students studying in those schools or colleges (situated in India) and affiliated to the Boards of Secondary Education or Universities of the foreign countries. Students passing the qualifying examinations from Boards or Universities located in foreign countries as external students and dependants of NRI studying in India will not be included as International students. Entry level status of International students on entry to the country will be maintained, i.e., if the applicant entered the country through a student visa, it will remain the same throughout the duration of the course. The applicant cannot change the type of visa during the course of the study. Wards of NRI parents are eligible for admissions to NRI category

1.2 Documents required for admission of International Students:

- VISA: All the international students will require a 'Student VISA' endorsed to Desh Bhagat University, Mandi Gobindgarh, Distt. Fatehgarh Sahib (Punjab) INDIA, PIN -147301 for joining full time courses. No other endorsement is acceptable. Students wishing to join a research program will require a 'Research VISA' endorsed to this institution. The visa should be valid for the prescribed duration of the course. Visa may be obtained after issuing offer of admission.
- A visa is not required for NRI students. Students who are doing full time courses, in some other institutions, do not require a separate visa for joining 'Part Time courses' provided that their current visa is valid for the entire duration of the course.
- All International Students wishing to undertake any research work or join a M.Sc/M.Phil/ PhD program will have to obtain prior security clearance from the Ministry of Home Affairs and the approval of Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India and this must be on the student visa/research visa endorsed to this University.

1.3 Eligibility: Qualifications

Only those Students who have qualified from foreign universities or Boards of Higher Education recognized as equivalent by the 'Association of Indian Universities' (AIU) are eligible for admission. When required, a reference will be made to AIU to check the equivalence. In case the University /Board is not included in the list, the candidate has to obtain and submit a certificate to this effect from AIU by paying the requisite fee. Submission of Equivalence Certificate from AIU is mandatory for foreign nationals. AIU address is given below.

1.4 Admission of International students:

Admission of all the International students will be done through the 'International Students Cell (ISC)' of DBU. Students will generally be admitted in the beginning of the course.

Eligible applicants need to certify that the medium of instruction for the qualifying examination passed is English. For applicants who have undertaken their studies in a language other than English need to have a valid IELTS/TOEFL score. Once this is submitted, the final admission is confirmed. The International students will have to pay the fees in US dollars or equivalent in Indian rupees. Fee has to be deposited in the form of Crossed Demand Draft / Bank Pay Order, drawn in favour of, DBU payable at Chandigarh as mentioned in the offer letter. The candidate can also pay the required amount of fee in the Account of DBU from any bank or Credit Card.

1.5 Transfers and change of course

An International student who has been granted admission to a particular course shall not be generally allowed to change the course. Transfer from one institution in India to another is also not allowed ordinarily.

1.6 Procedure for admissions

Stepwise procedure for admission of International Students for Full Time Courses in DBU The procedure for admission is given below:

Step 1:

- a). International students should apply on a separate form prescribed for Foreign nationals/NRI/Sponsored candidates.
- b) The candidate preferably has to apply/register on the prescribed form ONLINE only. He/she may also apply Offline. For this the candidate may contact the Incharge International Admissions (Contact No. +91 9875992866) office
- c). The application form registration fee of USD 200 is required to be paid through Online/ Bank Transfer to Indusind Bank account(Bank Name- Indusind Bank, Account Name Desh Bhagat University, Account Number- 20108364047, IFSC Code- INDB0000014, Swift Code- INDBINBBCHS) payable at Chandigarh. The candidate can also transfer the required amount of fee in the account of DBU from any bank or credit card. This should be done well in time, so that the student is able to obtain the VISA and No Objection Certificate before the due date of admission.

Step 2:

Get the 'Provisional Admission Offer Letter' from the International Admission Cell, in order to obtain the VISA (on payment of non-refundable advance amount of USD 2000 of the total annual fee).

Step 3:

Submit the 'Provisional Admission Offer Letter' to the Indian Embassy of the respective country for obtaining the 'Student VISA'.

Step 4:

Report at DBU for admission. Submit the below mentioned documents (in original along with the attested photo copies) and get them verified by the Office of International Admissions Cell.

- Degree/ Pass Certificate of the qualifying examination
- b) Mark list of the qualifying examination
- c) 'Student VISA' in Original
- d) A photo copy of the Passport- duly attested by a Notary. Note: The original certificates will be returned to the students immediately after making an endorsement to this effect.

Step 5:

Students are required to undergo the medical fitness examination and get the medical fitness certificate. As per government rules all international students entering India on 'Student VISA' have to be tested for HIV and will not be given admission, if found to be positive. All international students will be required to pay prescribed medical fees, which includes the medical insurance cover for the first year. For subsequent years medical insurance fees will be the same as for other Indian students and is included in other fees.

Step 6:

For applicants who have undertaken their studies in a language other than English need to have a valid IELTS/TOEFL Score. It is mandatory for an International / NRI student, who either fails / secures less than the desired scores or fails to appear in this proficiency test, to join the English Language Foundation Course of either 03 months or 06 months duration (depending on the scores secured in the proficiency test). In addition to the annual and other fees of the main program of study at DBU, students will also have to pay for this English Language Foundation Course as per the Institute prescribed fee structure

Step 7:

Admission of International /NRI students will be confirmed after verification of original certificates, medical fitness test and payment of required fees. Even after the admission, at any stage if it is noted that the qualifying Degree/ Certificate is not recognized by AIU, the admission of the candidate may be cancelled. Withdrawal of admissions/ refund of fees cases will be dealt as per the guidelines of DBU in this regard.

Step 8:

Within a week of arrival in India, students are required to register their names with the police in the 'Foreigner Regional Registration Office (FRRO)' of Shri Fetehgarh Sahib, Tel.: +91 9875996703 Email: admissioncellhead@deshbhagatuniversity.in

1.7 Discipline:

The International students should abide by all the rules of DBU and the code of conduct as applicable to Indian students enrolled in the same courses. Examination and award of Degrees & Diplomas: The procedure for examination, payment of examination fees, issue of mark list, issue of passing certificates and award of degrees will be same as for the Indian students doing the same courses.

1.8 Guidelines for admission of NON-RESIDENT INDIAN (NRI) students

Non Resident Indian Seats (NRI) (Applicable to all Programmes for which NRI seats are allotted): Out of the total approved seats (Seats available) of M.Sc. five seats are set apart as NRI seats with a different fee structure. NRI Status is not essential to apply for these seats. Allotment to NRI seats are made on the basis of meeting eligibility criteria and passing the entrance exam as applicable. Candidates who intend to apply for NRI seats must apply online and secure a valid rank in the prescribed test. Those who intend to be considered to NRI seats should invariably choose "NRI" during the process of online application, remit the application fee of USD 200 Registration fees and should submit the 'Declaration' given in Annexure I during the time of admission. Those who have applied for NRI seats shall be considered automatically for Non-NRI seats as their first option and for NRI seats as their second option. If NRI option is not availed during the online application process the candidate will not be able to opt for NRI seats and no modification will be possible at a later stage. However, for spot admissions, if any, all candidates can appear by paying USD 200 as NRI Registration fees, provided balance NRI seats are available.

Note: The above rules and guidelines will be strictly followed. In case, there are any differences on the interpretation of rules then the opinion of the 'International Students Cell' will be final. Students will have to pay the revised fee, when applicable. On the points not specifically covered, the decision of competent authorities of DBU will be final.

Rules and Regulations

Evaluation and Examination

Scheme of Evaluation and Examination

Desh Bhagat University shall carry a total of 100 marks. Marks are allocated in both Continuous Assessment, Mid-Semester Examination and End-Semester Examination.

Attendance

Eligibility to Appear in End-Semester Examination: Students having less than 75% attendance in a course shall not be permitted to take the End-Semester Examination for that course.

Mid-Semester Examinations

The Mid-Semester Examinations shall be held approximately mid-way between the commencement and the conclusion of each semester.

End-Semester Examination

End-Semester Examinations shall be held at the conclusion of each semester.

Fee

During no dues period, the student will have to deposit the fees for the next semester.
