General course and has also successfully completed a Diploma in Special Education in the respective disability area, recognized by the Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI), with a minimum of 50% marks in each course.</p> <p>C. A candidate who has passed the PG Diploma (till the academic session 2014-15) in the relevant field is also eligible.</p> <p>D. A candidate with a B.Ed. in a specific specialization may be eligible for admission to the M.Ed. in Cross Disability / Multi-category (if offered). However, the reverse is not allowed—B.Ed. with Multi-category specialization cannot be admitted to a M.Ed. in a single disability specialization. As part of the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), candidates with a B.Ed. in Multi-category may be admitted to the B.Ed. Special Education (B.Ed. Spl. Ed.) Area C courses, where they will complete the specialization courses required to qualify in a specific disability area.
